Dear CWA District 1 Member,

The Dues Increase Referendum is being conducted by secret ballot using the telephone and Internet, through the BallotPoint Election Services voting system. To vote, follow the instructions shown on the back of this page. You may vote only once, using either the telephone or Internet. If you have any questions, please contact your Local Ratification Vote Coordinator listed on the back.

Voting in this election opens at 8:00 AM ET on Monday, February 22, 2016 and closes at 5:00 PM ET on Friday, March 4, 2016.



BALLOT STATEMENT

2. Enter the **ID** shown on the front of this page.

For almost all members, the ID is the last 6 digits of the SSN (Social Security Number) followed by the member's 5-digit zip code. *In a few cases*, multiple members shared the same SSN6+ZIP5. If you are one of those members, the ID to use does not follow this SSN6+ZIP5 pattern, and the ID to use is shown on the front of this page. *Please note that the voting system does not have your entire SSN.*
